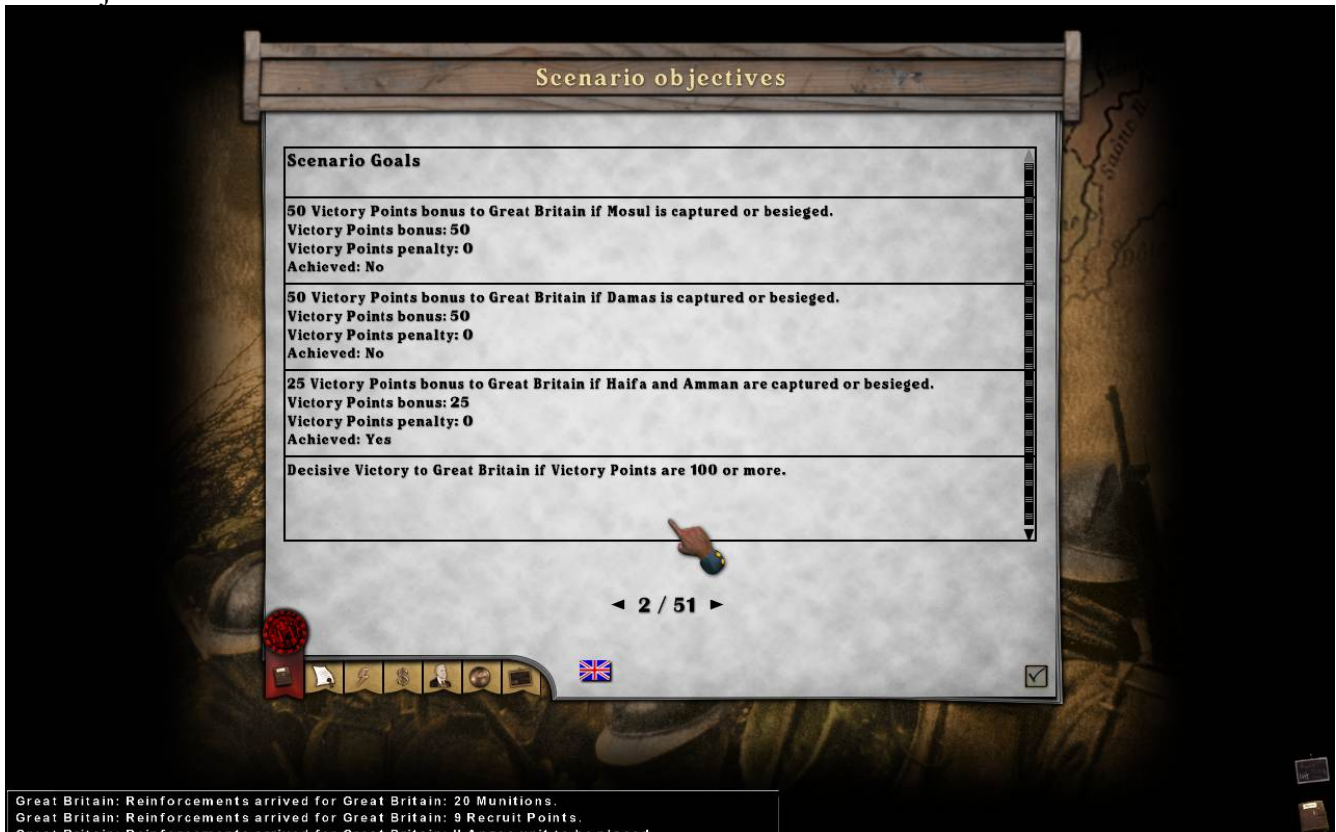


My setup:

Allenby is set to advance on Beirut and Amman. Aircraft are set to do Reconnaissance

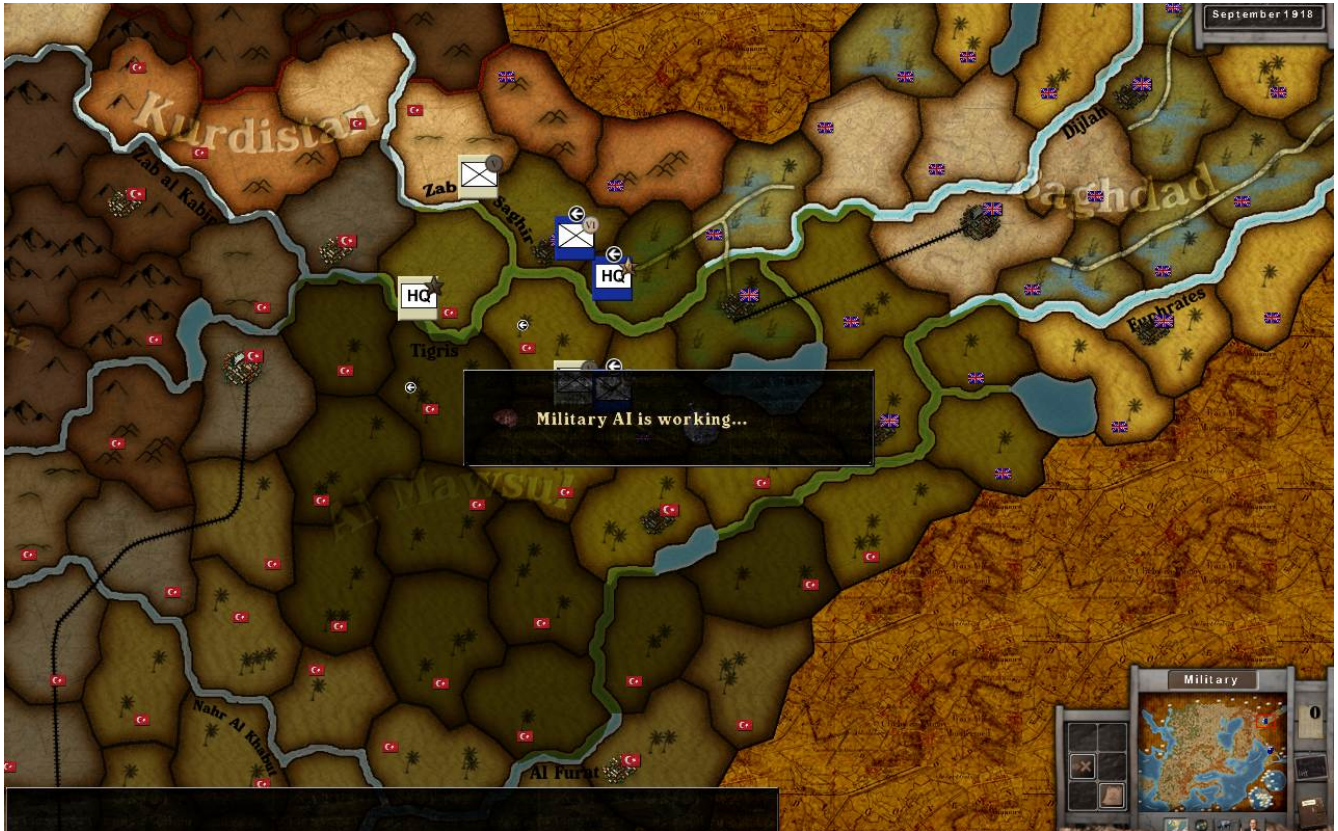


Townsend is set to advance on Mosul.
